### Course:

The second semester (from April 2023 to September 2023) Starter's Japanese language class 2

# Class Objectives:

- 1.To be able to understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction on needs of a concrete type.
- 2. To be able to introduce him/herself and others and ask and answer questions about personal details such as where he/she lives, people whom he/she knows and things he/she has.
- 3. To be able to interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help. (JF Standard for Japanese Language Education A1 Level)
- 4. To be able to read and write hiragana, katakana and basic kanji.
