Course :

The second semester (from April 2023 to September 2023)

Beginner's Japanese language class

Class Objectives :

- 1. To be able to understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment).
- 2. To be able to communicate in simple and routine requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters.
- 3. To be able to describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need. (JF Standard for Japanese Language Education A2 Level)
- 4. To be able to read sentences including basic kanji characters.

Class Hours :

One hour a week (20 weeks in each semester)

Learning Content :

- 1. To study grammar, vocabulary and expressions necessary to achieve the "Objectives 1,2,3" above, and practice conversation.
- 2. To read reading section of each lesson in the textbook and comprehend it.
