To be able to communicate in simple and routine requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters.</li> <li>3. To be able to describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need. (JF Standard for Japanese Language Education A2 Level)</li> <li>4. To be able to read sentences including basic kanji characters.</li> </ol>
